SPECIAL VOTERS' MEETING: The Coordinating Council has called for a special Voters' Meeting TODAY, March 1 at 11:45 am after second service in the Sanctuary of the church. The Coordinating Council proposes that we accept the bid for \$51,000 from Mauer Heating and Cooling to install a new forced air heating and cooling system at Zion church. The Council proposes that we begin work on this new system at the end of the current heating season.
