Open letter to the congregation:

As you can see in the bulletin the Coordinating Council has scheduled a Special Voters' Meeting for Sunday, April 17 at 11:30 a.m. for the purpose of eliminating the position of our church/school secretary effective April 30, 2016. The Council will also recommend extending the cuts next year when the budget is presented to the voters at our Annual Meeting in June. Cuts are not a fun thing to deal with but the decision was made for the following reasons:

- We are considerably behind in the budget for this fiscal year. (\$25,000)
- We have not made up any ground on the past due bills, mainly past due pension payments from previous years. (\$37,000)

Such a cut will have effects on the congregation however. Some of the changes the congregation will see will be:

- No more yearly Annual Report
- No more monthly newsletters. This will lead to additional savings on postage and paper costs
- No more services on the Power Point projector on Sundays
- Bulletins that contain the entire service would be eliminated
- The church office would be unstaffed when pastor is gone on hospital and shut-in calls

The biggest effect would be that our pastor would have less time to do ministerial work and would be spending time on clerical and administration duties.

As I stated earlier, cutting staff is not a fun thing to do. Our Council felt that based on the current's years finances, something needed to be done before the end of this fiscal year. The budget will also show the cut in the secretary's position. This will save \$20,000 per year in wages, plus some other costs such as paper, postage and payroll taxes which might total another \$2,000-3,000.

Please give these changes prayerful thought before our special Voters' Meeting April 17 at 11:30 a.m. after second service.
