VOTER'S MEETING RECAP: 19 voters attended the Voter's meeting on Sunday, June 7, 2015. Reports from the various committee chairmen were given. Robert Wille reported that he is currently holding \$25,000 in unpaid bills, most of which is for the pension fund. The voters adopted a budget of \$292,348.00 for the 2015-2016 fiscal year. Pastor Thomford noted that we have given \$800.00 of our \$5,000.00 mission subscription for 2015. The voters approved the replacement of a window in Karen Thomford's classroom at a cost of about \$900.00. Pastor Thomford and Robert Wille reported on the possibility of acquiring two parcels of land east of the school property. The owner wishes to get rid of the property, and Zion could possibly own the property for simply paying the back taxes on the land. The voters gave permission to the Council to pursue this issue and find out more information.

Our current secretary, Katie Augustine, will be stepping down as secretary to be a stay-at-home mom. Her last day of work will be July 31, 2015.
