INSTALLATION OF NEW CHURCH OFFICERS: Today, during both the 8:00 a.m. and 10:30 a.m. services, the new Church Officers elected at last week's Voters Meeting will be installed in front of the congregation.

VOTERS' MEETING LAST SUNDAY: Approximately 25 men attend the semi-annual voters' meeting last Sunday. If he is able to make the pension payments on time for the next 6 months, the WELS Benefit Office, may forgive approximately \$5,000 in interest on past due payments for the pension fund. Bids have been received for the new roof on the church but the Property Board is still seeking bids. Approximately \$14,000 has been received for the new roof.
