LWMS Report: Greetings from the White Mountains of Arizona where world Missionary John Holtz and his wife Mindy have been living since September 2022. There are six Lutheran congregations on the reservation and three on the San Carlos Apache reservation. The church building is built of Tufa stone. It is light and can be picked up with ease. It was built in 1908 and still stands strong. It is the church where they teach ACTS - Apache Christian Training School. The cornerstone stands out because it is inscribed with the words JESUS CHRIST THE CHIEF CORNERSTONE! Pray for these missionaries that they have success in learning the Native American culture and language and that the Holy Spirit works in the hearts of those who hear God's Word.
