CLASSROOM UPDATES

Mr. Augustine:

Math – All students in Mr. Augustine's class will have a math test on Tuesday morning. Reading 56- This week, we will begin reading *Monkey Island*, a fictional novel about an abandoned boy in New York City and how he learns to live on the streets. **Reading 78-** Our week will begin with a wrap-up from our previous story and end the week with research reports and learning how to create a works cited page.

Grammar 56- punctuation symbols such as apostrophes, hyphens, dashes, and parentheses will be taught this week before a review comes on Wednesday.

Grammar 78- Titles of books, poems, movies, etc will be discussed on Monday before a large review in the middle of the week.

Science 56- Students will begin a unit on Weather this week, with a focus early in the week on the types of clouds. Science 78- Our new unit on rocks begins this week. Students will learn the three categories of rocks, and how they are used in our world today.
